


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Red Line Greenway










Cuyahoga River Water Trail

The acquisition includes Edgewater Park, Edgewater Yacht Club, Edgewater Marina, Forest City Yacht Club, Lakeside Yacht Club, East 55th Marina, East 72nd Fishing Area, Intercity Yacht Club, North Gordon Park, Euclid Beach Park, and the Wildwood-Villa Angela properties. The Euclid Beach, Villa Angela, and Wildwood are along Euclid Creek and became part of Euclid Creek Reservation. The remainder of the properties form the Park District's 18th reservation, Lakefront Reservation.







Acacia Reservation Restoration

The former Acacia Country Club in Lyndhurst became Cleveland Metropark's 17th reservation in 2012, with a stipulation that it be restored to a natural state. A major restoration removed subsurface drain structures, restored small tributaries to Euclid Creek, and restored the incised main channel of the creek to reconnect it to a functional floodplain along with adding meanders. Native plantings, vastly reduced mowing, and the addition of hundreds of tree seedlings are transforming this former golf course to a thriving natural habitat.

Seneca Golf Course Renovation
