In 2023, Volunteer Services focused on capacity building to meet the growing needs of the community. New positions were added to the team as well as equipment trailers supported by the Cleveland Metroparks Emerald Necklace Endowment. Volunteers helped launch new initiatives such as our Volunteer Recycling Program and supported community events focused on inclusion, diversity, equity and accessibility. The tireless efforts of our 1,626 ongoing volunteers, who dedicated 102,909 hours of their time, enriched countless programs throughout the Park District and Zoo.

Cleveland Metroparks also benefited from the volunteer efforts of 5,571 community members who donated 21,050 hours of their time to short-term and group volunteer projects. Of that total, 1,833 Adopt-a-Beach volunteers spent 3,701 hours keeping our beaches free of debris.

Volunteer Services successfully coordinated the second year of the Employee Volunteer Program, which played a pivotal role in Cleveland Metroparks receiving the Smart Business Pillar Award for Community Service. The Volunteer Services Department garnered another accolade as Lynne Lisner, its director, was named Volunteer Administrator of the Year by the Forum for Volunteer Administrators.

We cannot thank our volunteers enough for their selfless contributions this past year, which continue to leave a lasting impact on both Cleveland Metroparks and the communities we serve.
