

1st Quarter Review

- \$200,000 from the **Cleveland Foundation** for Lakefront legal fees and urban beach ambassador program

- \$5,000 from ArcelorMittal's Environment grant program for the Riverwalk Trail
- \$2,269 from the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District's 2013 Recycling Container Grant program for recycling containers at West Creek Stewardship Center
