Key Responsibilities and activities may include (but are not limited to):

- Assist with Summer Camps and Garden:
 - Gather supplies, help set up activities, help monitor campers, be an active participant in activities, help clean up from the camp day
 - Help with watering the garden and weeding as necessary
- Shadow staff on hikes and interpretive programs
 - Assist as needed with preparation, during the program, and clean up
- Assisting with the daily operation of the welcome desk of the center
- Participate in event tables and drop-by tables to educate public on local wildlife
- Assisting with animal care includes: tank cleaning, animal feeding, and learning about our education animal ambassadors to interact with the public
